ORDER DENYING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Respondent filed a motion seeking reconsideration of the Attorney Discipline Board's March 24, 2025 order affirming in part and vacating in part findings of misconduct, increasing discipline from a five-year suspension to disbarment, and affirming restitution. The Grievance Administrator filed a response requesting that respondent's motion be denied.

The Board has considered respondent's motion together with the response filed by the Grievance Administrator, and is otherwise fully advised;

NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED that respondent's motion for reconsideration is **DENIED**. Respondent's motion merely presents the same issues already ruled on by the Board. Respondent has failed to demonstrate a palpable error by which the Board has been misled, or to otherwise

demonstrate that the March 24, 2025 decision of the Board was entered erroneously, such that correction of the alleged errors would result in a different disposition.
